

# 2012 VOTING RECORD IOWA GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Samuel Gompers said it best when he described labor's political mission nearly a century ago: "Stand faithfully by our friends and elect them; oppose our enemies and defeat them, whether they be candidates for President, for Congress, or other offices, whether executive, legislative or judicial."

This voting record covers only <u>recorded</u> votes of the Iowa House and Iowa Senate that are of interest to labor. Thus, unfortunately, not all of our priorities for 2012 are in the record, and we must use other means to determine legislators' positions on those issues until such time as there is an official vote. This record does, however, serve as a tool to help Iowa trade unionists assess whether or not their elected representatives support a more progressive agenda.

#### Senate Issues – 2012

## 1. JUSTICE SYSTEM SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS

(SF 2071)

Iowa's prisons and Justice System is understaffed and needed more funding to finish the fiscal year. The Senate set levels higher than the Governor and the House to provide the correct amount of funding.

IFL position was "YES."

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 23 no (Final version was a compromise between House and Senate, was passed by both chambers, and was signed by the Governor)

## 2. EXPANSION OF EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

(SF 2161)

Raised the Earned Income Tax Credit from 7% to 20% over the course of several years.

IFL position was "YES."

Senate Vote: Passed 48 yes – 0 no (Passed Senate but was rolled into Property Tax Bills that did not pass)

#### 3. STRAY VOLTAGE IMPACTS

(SF 2286)

Provides for the adoption of administrative rules by the Iowa Utilities Board establishing standard procedures and protocols for the measurement of stray current or voltage.

IFL position was "YES."

Senate Vote: Passed 35 yes – 14 no (Passed Senate but died in House Committee)

#### 4. AMERICAN PRODUCTS

(SF 2287)

Requires each contract for the construction of a public improvement made by a governmental unit to contain a provision requiring that the iron, steel, and manufactured goods used or supplied in the performance of the contract or any subcontract be manufactured in the United States.

#### IFL position was "YES."

Senate Vote: Passed 37 yes – 13 no (Passed Senate and died in House Committee)

#### 5. ALLOWABLE GROWTH

(SF 2115)

Sets the allowable growth for the public school system at 4%.

IFL position was "YES."

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 23 no (Passed Senate and died in House Committee)

## 6. PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING TRUST FUND

(SF 2335)

Establishes a board and trust fund to be used for public safety training costs incurred by the state, a city, or county.

IFL position was "YES."

Senate Vote: Passed 35 yes – 13 no (Passed Senate and died in House Committee)

## 7. HOUSE COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY TAX CUTS

(S 5258 to SF 2344)

The House Republican version of property tax reform would have left cities and other local governments without resources forcing them to increase residential rates, lay off public employees, cut services, or all of the above. This was offered as an amendment to a Senate property tax bill.

IFL position was "NO."

Senate Vote: 21 yes – 26 no (Amendment failed)

#### House Issues – 2012

#### 1. CHILD LABOR

(Amendment H-8006 to HF 2227)
House Republicans offered an amendment to a technical bill from Iowa Workforce Development to eliminate required Child Labor reporting to the state of Iowa. H-8006 would have corrected this problem.

#### IFL position was "YES."

House Vote: Failed 42 yes – 57 no (Bill passed House, but died in Senate Committee)

## 2. JUDICIAL SYSTEM SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATONS

(Amendment H-8020 to SF 2071) Iowa's prisons and Justice System is understaffed and needed more funding to finish the fiscal year. This amendment offered by House Democrats would have restored supplemental funding to the higher Senate level instead of the House Republican level.

#### IFL position was "YES."

House Vote: Failed 39 yes – 57 no (Final version was a compromise between House and Senate, was passed by both chambers, and was signed by the Governor)

## 3. STANDING APPROPRIATIONS (HF2465)

The first incarnation of the Standing Appropriations Bill included provisions that required State employees to pay at least 25% of already-bargained-for health care benefits.

#### IFL position was "NO."

House Vote: Passed 59 yes – 40 no (Later version that did not include state employee health insurance changes did pass both chambers)

# 4. HOUSE COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY TAX CUTS

(HF 2475)

House Republican version of property tax reform would have left cities and other local governments without resources forcing them to increase residential rates, lay off public employees, cut services, or all of the above.

#### IFL position was "NO."

House Vote: Passed 71 yes – 26 no (House version was not taken up by Senate except in Amendment form and failed)
