IOWA GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Samuel Gompers said it best when he described labor's political mission nearly a century ago: "Stand faithfully by our friends and elect them; oppose our enemies and defeat them, whether they be candidates for President, for Congress, or other offices, whether executive, legislative or judicial."

This voting record covers only recorded votes of the Iowa House and Iowa Senate that are of interest to labor. Thus, unfortunately, not all of our priorities for 2013 are in the record, and we must use other means to determine legislators' positions on those issues until such time as there is an official vote. This record does, however, serve as a tool to help Iowa trade unionists assess whether or not their elected representatives support a more progressive agenda.

Senate Issues – 2013

1. UNEMPLOYMENT WAITING PERIOD

(Amendment S-3007 to SF 110)

This amendment, sponsored by Sen. Bertrand (R-Sioux City) to an unemployment bill that the state needed to pass to bring Iowa into conformity with U.S. Trade Laws, would have required a one-week waiting period before a worker would be able to collect unemployment benefits.

IFL position was “NO.”

Senate Vote: 22 yes – 27 no

(Amendment failed)

2. VOTER SUPPRESSION AMENDMENT

(Amendment S-3242 to Amendment S-3223 to SF 452)

This amendment, sponsored by 11 Senate Republicans to the Senate version of the Standing Appropriations bill, would have placed new-voter identification rules and made it much harder for citizens to vote.

IFL position was “NO.”

Senate Vote: 24 yes – 26 no

(Amendment failed)

3. SCHOOL CATEGORICAL GROWTH FY 2013-2014

(SF 51)

This bill would have funded the fiscal year 2013-2014 school year categorical growth aid at 4%.

IFL position was “YES.”

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 23 no

(Passed Senate, was not taken up by the House)

4. SCHOOL ALLOWABLE GROWTH FY 2013-2014

(SF 52)

This bill would have funded the fiscal year 2013-2014 Allowable Growth for Iowa schools at 4%.

IFL position was “YES.”

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 23 no

(Passed Senate, was not taken up by the House)

5. EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

(SF 422)

This bill would have increased the Earned Income Tax Credit from 7% to 20%.

IFL position was “YES.”

Senate Vote: Passed 35 yes – 15 no

(Passed Senate, was not taken up by the House)

6. MEDICAID EXPANSION

(SF 296)

This bill would have expanded Medicaid coverage to Iowans earning up to 138% of poverty, as outlined in the Affordable Care Act.

IFL position was “YES.”

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 23 no

(Passed Senate, was later amended by the House)

7. SCHOOL CATEGORICAL GROWTH 4% FY 2014-2015

(SF 161)

This bill would have set the categorical growth for schools at 4% for fiscal year 2014-2015.

IFL position was “YES.”

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 22 no

(Passed Senate, was not taken up by the House)

8. SCHOOL ALLOWABLE GROWTH FY 2014-2015

(SF 162)

This bill would have set the allowable growth for schools at 4% for fiscal year 2014-2015.

IFL position was “YES.”

Senate Vote: Passed 26 yes – 22 no

(Passed Senate, was not taken up by the House)

9. PROPERTY TAXES

(SF 295)

Though an increase to the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) was included in this bill, it was not a balanced approach. SF 295 cut property taxes for big business and will drain the state budget of over 3 billion dollars over ten years, and set up local governments to face shortfalls in the future.

IFL position was “NO.”

Senate Vote: Passed 43 yes – 6 no

(Passed Senate and House, signed by Governor)

House Issues – 2013

1. PUBLIC EMPLOYEE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING

(Amendment H-1427 to the committee amendment H-1404 to SF 452)

This amendment would have removed from the House version of the Standings Appropriations bill, an attempt to change the collective bargaining process for state employees regarding health benefits.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Failed 43 yes – 52 no

2. MEDICAID EXPANSION

(Amendment H-1373 to SF 296)

This amendment was to strike the Senate’s Medicaid Expansion plan from legislation intended to implement the affordable care act.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 51 yes – 49 no

3. GOVERNOR’S HEALTHY IOWA PLAN

(SF 296 as amended by the Iowa House)

After the Iowa House amended SF 296, this vote was taken to pass the Governor’s Healthy Iowa Plan, which cost the state more, covered less people, and covered fewer services than the Senate Medicaid Expansion plan.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 51 yes – 49 no, as amended

4. PROPERTY TAX – On the question, “Shall the bill pass?”

(SF 295)

This property tax cut was one of the largest tax cuts in Iowa history draining the state budget of over 3 billion dollars over ten years, and would also leave a significant funding gap for local governments as well.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 84 yes – 13 no

(Passed Senate, House and signed by the Governor)

5. CHILD LABOR IN LAUNDRY OPERATIONS

(HF 547)

This bill would have allowed child labor in laundry operations, which is currently prohibited.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 53 yes – 45 no

6. TAXPAYER TRUST FUND

(On the question, Shall amendment H-1078 to HF 478 be adopted?)

This amendment would give the balance of the “taxpayer trust fund” to Iowans in the form of a tax credit. IFL believes that, with these funds available, there would be better opportunities to invest in our future.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 53 yes – 46 no

7. INCOME TAX ALTERNATIVE

(HF 478)

This bill allows someone to choose to pay a flat tax instead of the current system of calculating state income tax liabilities. This first step in moving towards a permanent flat tax could cause the state to lose over a billion dollars in revenue.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 53 yes – 47 no

(Passed as amended)

8. LUSTER HEIGHTS FUNDING

(Amendment H-1360, to the committee amendment H-1329, to SF 447)

This amendment would have restored funding to keep Luster Heights correctional facility open.

IFL position was “YES.”

House Vote: Failed 47 yes – 51 no

(Failed as amended)

9. JUSTICE SYSTEM BUDGET

(SF 447)

This House version of the Justice system budget removed the funding allocated by the Senate that would have helped to properly staff our state’s prisons.

IFL position was “NO.”

House Vote: Passed 51 yes – 46 no

10. WORKFORCE OFFICES

(Amendment H-1301, to the committee amendment H-1273 of SF 430)

This amendment would have reopened offices in Ames, Atlantic, Clinton, Denison, Keokuk and Newton, in addition to funding offices in Decorah, Ft. Madison, Iowa City and Webster City.

IFL position was “YES.”
